 Patrick Creagh of Baltimore County painter W^{it}nes both That y^e
 Patrick Murphy for and in Consideration of y^e Sum of Thirty
 two pounds Curr money of Maryland to him in hand by y^e Patrick
 Creagh well & truly payd & satisfied y^e receipt whereof is here by
 acknowledged Hath Given granted Bargained sold Aliened Enfeoffed
 Confirmed & made over by these presents to y^e Patrick Creagh
 self and his heirs God Grant Bargain^{sell} Alien Enfeoff^{firm}
 firm & make over unto him y^e Patrick Creagh his heirs and assigns
 for ever all those severall tracts or parcell^s of Land According to
 their severall & respective mostes and bounds hereinafter Expre
 ssed all lying in Baltimore County & That is to say all that
 tract or parcell of Land called y^e Cuckold makers p^{ar}cell lying on
 Hunting Ridge Originally taken upon or about y^e first day of
 June Anno Dom One thousand seven hundred Beginning at
 a bounded white Oak of South East Corner tree of Crowleys Contriv
 ance Running thence South East One hundred thirty three
 perches to a bounded Hill thence North East One hundred
 & two perches thence Northwest One hundred thirty three
 perches to y^e first boundary containing One hundred Acres
 more or less also all that Tract or parcell of Land called Murph
 ys pleasure lying on y^e North side of potapsco River at Burton
 Ridge Beginning at three bounded Red Oaks running thence
 North East two hundred & fifty two perches to a bound Spanish
 Oak by Quins falls side thence & down y^e falls South South
 East Eighty eight perches to an Elbow of y^e falls then crossing
 y^e falls South East & by South Ninety perches to a bound
 on a point in another Elbow of said falls then South West by
 South fifty four perches to a bound white Oak standing in y^e
