forever That he given granted bargained sold Aliened in feoffed Remised
Released and confirmed and by these presents Doth give grant bargain
sell Alien in feoff Remise Release and confirm unto him the said
Charles Worthington his heirs and Assignes for ever All them three
Tracts or parcels of land called Ridgley's Range Hunting Ground and
part of Broken Land lying and being on the East side the middle River
of Patuxent the two first Tracts lying in Baltimore County and the
