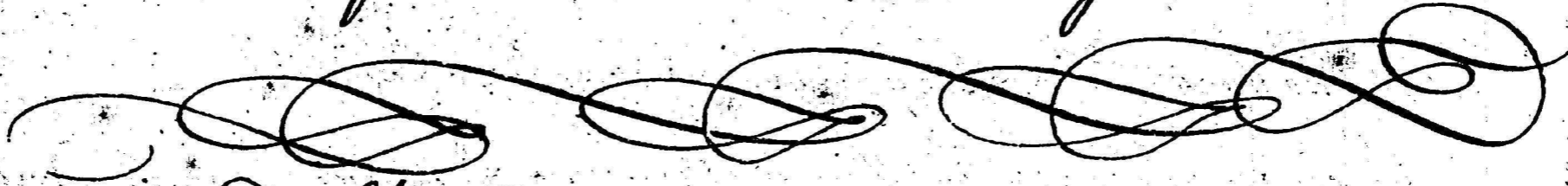

Jointly and severally for the whole and in the whole firmly by these
presents sealed with Our Seals dated the fifteenth day of July in the
Thirteenth year of his Lordships Dominion Anno Dni 1727

The Condition of the above written Obligation is such that if the above
bound Charles Calvert whilst he shall continue in the Office of Commissary
Generall shall at his own proper Cost and Charge send a supply of good sufficient
Record Books necessary for the Entering up of all matters and things relating to
such Commissary Offices and shall duly and carefully look after procure and
maintain the severall books of Records now being and remaining in the said
Office as also that from time to time shall be added thereto in such manner
as that when he shall be dismissed from Officiating longer in the said Office
shall deliver all the aforesaid Records to the next person that succeeds in the
said Office in good Order and repair according to the true intent and meaning
of the Act of Assembly in that Case made and provided That then the above
written Obligation to be void and of no Effect otherwise to remain in full force
and virtue in Law
