presence of the witnesses hereafter named Personally appeared  
Mr. Walter Bowen of London Merchant who declared to have made and  
constituted authorized and appointed and by these presents doth make  
Ordain constitute authorize and appoint Mr. George Walker of the province  
of Maryland Gent his true and Lawfull Attorney giving & by these  
presents granting unto his said attorney full Power and Lawfull Authority  
for him the said Constituant in his name and to him or to his Demand  
Seay sue for and by all Lawfull waies and means recover & receive  
of and from all and every or any person or persons of what Degree or quality  
soever whom it shall or may concern inhabiting in the province of  
Maryland. aft or else where in America all and every or any such Sum  
and Sums of Money Goods wares Merchandizes Effects Estate & things in force  
which now are or shall or may hereafter be due owing belonging or in  
any way appertaining to him the said Constituant who ther by bond note bill
