 Richerton of Ann Arundell County in y^e province of y^e
 other part witnesseth that whereas a certain Will
 Deavor of Calver County in y^e province of Virginia
 Indentured bearing date y^e fourth of June 1708 Thow 1000
 hundred & thirteen bargain sell convey and make over
 unto y^e John Orrell his heirs & assigns for ever
 a certain piece or parcel of Land w^{ch} all its appurtenances
 being part of a Tract of Land in Ann Arundell County
 of y^e called Braughton Ashley Beginning at a bounded
 Hickory standing near a bounded ~~tree~~ being y^e
 third bounded Tree of Emertons Land part of
 y^e said Tract and running from Thence East Eighty
 perches to a bounded Hickory being likewise a bounded
 Tree of y^e Emertons Land Thence North fifty two
 perches to a bounded Hickory standing in y^e Line
 of y^e Land called Nats Chants and running w^{ch} y^e said
 Land West thirty three perches to a bounded oak of y^e Land
