Over unto him the said Peter Atwood his heirs & assigns
for ever all the Estate both Real & Personall consisting
partly of Some Tracts or parcelles of Land Lying and
being in Maryland or else where & partly consisting
of Goods & Chattells Given & bequeathed by the aforesaid
Thomas Hodgson who was Devisee of Thomas Mansell
Some time an Inhabitant at or near Bohemia River
in Cecil County by his Last will unto the aforesaid
Jⁿ. Bennett.
