This Indenture made the thirteenth day of July in the year of our Lord God Anno Domini One thousand seven Hundred and Twenty Eight between George Brown and Mary his wife of Bactinore County in the Province of Maryland Planter of the one part & Robert Boon of Ann Arundell County Planter of the other part. Witnesseth that the said George Brown and Mary his wife for & in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid or secured to be paid the receipt whereof he the said George Brown & Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge & doth clearly acquit Exonerate and discharge the said Robert Boon his heirs and assigns for ever. That given granted bargained sold aliened Enjoined and confirmed & by these presents he doth give grant bargain sell aliened Enjoine and confirm unto the said Robert Boon his heirs and assigns for ever a parcel of Land lying in Bactinore County lying on the West side of Jones's Laces called by the name of Edwards and Wills Valleys and hills and part of the Enlargement
