

This Invention made the tenth day of August in the year of our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred and twenty eight Between Richard Harrison of Philadelphia County in the Province of Pennsylvania Merchant and Hannah his wife of the One part And Samuel Harrison of Anne Arundell County in the Province of Maryland Merchant of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Harrison for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and fifty pounds Sterling to him the said Richard in hand already paid by the said Samuel Harrison Have given Grant Bargaind Sold as by these presents they the said Richard Harrison and Hannah his wife Do for themselves severally and their heirs Give grant Bargain Sole Alien Dispose Confirm and make Good unto the said Samuel Harrison his heirs & assigns forever all those parts of two tracts of Land one called Abbingdon Manor the other called Dowdall that were devised and bequeathed unto the said Richard Harrison his heirs and assigns forever by Richard Harrison father of Samuel and Richard parties to these presents some time of late past in the aforesaid province of Maryland Gentleman deceased as in and by the last will and Testament of Richard the father bearing date on or about the tenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirtie may appear which said two tracts of Land called Abbingdon Manor and Dowdall as aforesaid were conveyed unto the said Richard Harrison the father and John Biggs, the seventh day of November in the sixth year of the reign of the Lady Anne Queen of Great Britain in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Seven by Messrs. John Hyde and Isaac Milner of London Merchants for the consideration in the deed of conveyance expressed as in and by the said deed relation being thereunto had doth and may more fully and at large appear to gather the all and singular the Improvements Conveyances and Advantages to the parts so bequeathed as aforesaid belonging or in any manner of way appertaining to the only use and behoof of him the said Samuel Harrison his heirs and assigns forever and to no other use Intent or purpose whatsoever So have and to hold the parts of the aforesaid Abbingdon Manor Dowdall bequeathed by Richard Harrison the father to Richard Harrison the son and parties to these presents together with all and singular the Improvements to the parts of the said Land so bequeathed as aforesaid belonging (unto)

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
