Woolf and Richard Woolf shall and will make due Acknowledg<sup>mt</sup> suffer and Execute all things such further Act and Acts thing and things devised and Devices whatsoever for the further and better conveying assuring and Incom<sup>ing</sup> making of the aforesaid fifty and acres of Land the aforesaid three Negro Slaves and also the aforesaid Cattle Sheep hogg<sup>s</sup> horse and Man and all other the hereby granted promises unto the said Dan: Maud and Sam: Howich their heirs and assigns forever as by the said Dan: Maud and Sam: Howich their heirs & assigns or them or their Council Learned in the Law shall be advised devised or required and then the said Eliz. Woolf and Richard Woolf their heirs & assigns the afo<sup>r</sup> fifty and acres of Land three Negro Slaves Cattle hogg<sup>s</sup> Sheep horse and Man and all other the hereby granted promises to the said Dan: Maud and Sam: Howich their heirs and assigns against them the said Eliz. Woolf and Richard Woolf their heirs & assigns and against all other persons whatsoever shall will warrant and for ever Defend and this agreed by and between the said parties to these presents that it shall and may be Lawfull to and for the said Eliz. Woolf and Richard Woolf their heirs and assigns to have hold use Occupie and receive and take all the rents Issues and profits of the aforesaid hereby granted promises untill Default shall be made in the payment of the afo<sup>r</sup> sum of one hundred & forty pound fifteen Shillings and three pence without any Let such trouble damage or Interruption of them the said Dan: Maud and Samuel Howich their heirs & assigns. The Witnesses whereof the said Eliz. Woolf and Rich<sup>d</sup>: Woolf have solemnly affixed their hands and Seals the day and year first above written.
