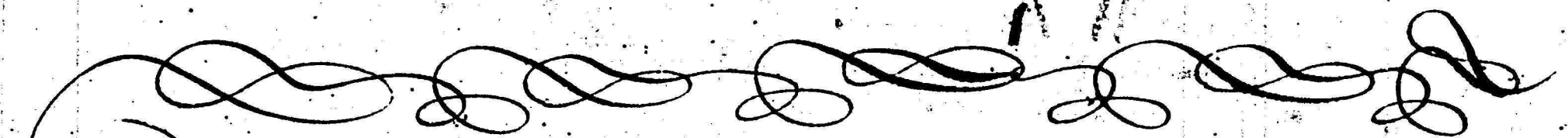

Sold, Granted and set Over unto the said Charles Drury
his heirs Executors administrators and assigns the
following Negroes Commonly Called. Joyce, Candess, Benn
Moll, Old Jenny, Charles, Amphibius, Tom Dick, young Jenny
and Peter, with their Increase for ever, as also all
my right Title and Interest in Corn Tobacco and Stock
of all sorts now in my possession with all the Household
Furniture on the plantation whereon I now live com-
monly Called by the Name of Henry or Harrys Lott
situated and lying in the County aforesaid or any
where else in the Province or County aforesaid to have &
to hold the above mentioned premises to him his
heirs Executors administrators & assigns as their own
proper Goods and Chattels to use and their own proper
Use & Uses for ever freely and easily without any
Molestation or Inconvenience from me my heirs
administrators or assigns further I promise and
agree to and with the said Charles Drury by these
presents to warrant and Defend the above and
