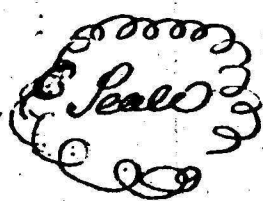

Special Grace we have pardoned unto Robert Lynch

as a proper Object of our Mercy the Subl of our peace
and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that—
The said Robert Lynch the sixth day of October—
in the year of Our Lord God One thousand seven
Hundred Twenty and eight with force and Arms to-
wit. with Guns Swords and Slaves the Mansion
House of James Dickinson Gent at St. Peters
Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid in the
night time to wit. about the second hour before
noon in the night of the same day the said James
Dickenson in the same House in the peace of
God and of us then being feloniously & Burglar-
iously did Break and Enter with an intent
