 ers and Causes touching or concerning the Premises
 To do say pursue Implead seize sequester Attach Impri-
 son and to Condemn and out of Prison Against to deliver
 Also to Compound Conclude & Agree by Arbitration or
 otherwise as their said Attorney shall think fit And
 Generally in the Premises to do perform & execute
 in as full and ample manner to all Intents Constr-
 uctions and purposes as they the said Constitutants
 might or could do if personally present And that Altho
 the Cause should require more ample or Especiall Power
 than is herein before particularly expressed with power
 to substitute one or more Attornies under him with
 Like or Limited Power and the same again to revoke
 they the said Constitutants hereby Joynly & severally
 promising to Ratify Confirm and hold for good and
 Valid all and whatsoever their said Attorney or his
 Substitutes shall Lawfully do or cause to be done
 in or about the Premises by Vertue of these presents
