void and annul the said former Commission and for Divers good
Causes and Considerations us therein to especially moving and also
by virtue of the Powers given in the Letters Patents from
King Charles the first to Cecilius ~~Lord~~ Baron of Baltimore
his heirs and assigns of the said Province of Maryland Have
constituted and appointed and by these presents do constitute and
appoint you the said Cecilius Calvert our Loving Brother and you
the said Thomas Beak Esq^r jointly to execute the office of
Secretary of the said Province of Maryland hereby authorizing
you and giving you full power with my own approbation to
nominate and appoint a sufficient Deputy to be present at
all Meetings of the Governour and Council of the Assembly in
