five shillings & two pence Silver money & three shillings

said Joseph Goage in the said House being found then
and there feloniously & Burglariously did steal take and
carry away against Our special Good Rule and Government
whereof he was Convicted before Our Trusty & well beloved Wm
Lock and John Smith Esq. Our Justices of Oyer and Terminer

gave unto him Our firm peace and will not that he
suffer any Corporal punishment therefore but that
