Maryland And forty Head of Sheep to him the  
said Thomas Homewood in paid or secured to be paid  
by the said William Worthington before the Enrolling  
and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged Itt is given Granted Bargained  
Sold Aliened Enfeoffed Confirmed and Made Good as  
by these presents he the said Thomas Homewood doth  
for himselfe and his heirs Give Grant Bargain Sell  
alien Enfeoff Confirme and make Over unto him  
the said William Worthington his heirs and Assignes  
for Ever all those severall Tracts or parcels of Land  
Following vizt a Tract or parcel of Land called  
Homewoods Range Containing Three Hundred Acres  
A Tract or parcel of Land called the Dividing points
