Deceased by his Last Will and Testament bearing Date the 1st day of December Anno Domini 1718 Among Other things therein did will and Bequeath unto Elinor Boyd, Joyce Bradford Margret Mkenemara & Mary Macey a Tract or part of Land lying in Baltimore County Called the ~~uncles~~ Goodwill Containing One Thousand Acres of Land as by the said Will Reference thereto being had may more at large appear which said Land by an Indenture bearing Date the tenth day of June 1730 was by the Joynt Consent of the said Elinor, Margerett, Joyce & Mary Divided as aforesaid and parties to the said Indenture Divided and allotted into four parts Dividends or allotments as by the said Deed Reference thereto being had may more at large appear the said Dividends or allotments being Numbered, One, Two, Three, four, which said ~~four~~ ^{fourth} allotment fell to and became the part of her the said Mary Macey. Now this Indenture further

Witnesseth that the said William Macey and Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of Thirty two pounds Ten Shillings Current Money of Maryland to them in hand paid and satisfied at and before the Executing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof they do here by acknowledge and thereof do acquit and discharge him the said Charles Carroll his heirs &c. & adm. Have Given Granted Bargained Sold Alien'd Enfeoff'd & Confirmed and do by these presents for them & their heirs give Grant Bargain, Sell, Alien, Enfeoff and Confirm unto him the said Charles Carroll his heirs and assigns for ever all their or either of their Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand of in and to the said Tract of Land Called the ~~uncles~~ Goodwill lying in Baltimore County aforesaid or to any part or parcell thereof which by the will aforesaid became their or either of their Right or Estate or
