 plantation called Delaware Bottom and also two thousand five
 hundred pounds of ~~the~~ tobacco in the hands of Mr. James Powell
 of Baltimore County To have and to hold all ^{the} and Negroes
 Corn Tobacco Goods and Chattles of unto him the said John
 Tailor his Executors Admrs and assignes as his and their own
 proper goods and Chattles without any manner of Condition or
 account to be rendered for the same and the said Benjamin Belt
 hath actually delivered unto the said John Tailor his Attorney
 in fact within this province all the ^{the} and Negroes goods and Chattles
 and the same Negroes goods and Chattles to the same John Tailor
 his Executors Admrs and assignes he the same Benjamin and
 his heirs Executors and Admrs shall and will warrant and for-
 ever hereafter defend from and against all manners of persons
