This Indenture made the second day of November Anno Dom: 1730 Betwixt Joshua George of Cecil County Gent of the one part and Benjamin Tasker Esq. & Cap: John Colvill of the other part witnesseth that the said Joshua George for and in consideration of the sume of three hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Benjamin Tasker and for and in consideration of One Hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said John Colvill at or before the Enscaling and delivery of these presents, from the same and every part whereof he ^{the} said Joshua George doth hereby legally Exonerate and Discharge the said Benjamin Tasker and John Colvill and each of them their and each of their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns Heath given granted Bargained sold Aliened Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents Doth give grant Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Benjamin Tasker and John Colvill their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever All that Tract or parcel of Land called Chestersfield lying and being in Kent County containing Five hundred Acres more or less. ALSO One thousand and forty dwellers of Land part of that Tract of Land called Middle Neck or Little Bohemia lying in Cecil County aforesaid and which said One thousand and forty five Acres begin at the point the beginning of the said Land called Middle Neck or Little Bohemia, and running from the said beginning up Great Bohemia River and with the said River in a straight line Six hundred and forty perches and then Cross the Neck to St. Augustines Creek or a branch thereof and then with such Lines and Courses to the said beginning as to include One thousand and forty five Acres of Land to be bounded by the water on each side ^{and} to include all the Land between the said straight line and water
