

This Indenture made the Eighth day of September Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and Thirty. Between William Worthington of Ann Arundell County in the Province of Maryland Gent of the One part. And Nathel Denton of the City of Annapolis in the same County Gent of the Other part witnesseth that the said William Worthington for and in Consideration of the sume of One hundred and ten pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to him in hand paid by the said Nathel Denton the receipt whereof the said William DOTH hereby acknowledge and thereof and from Every part and parcell thereof DOTH hereby fully and absolutely acquit Exonerate and Discharge Him the said Nathel his Heirs Executors and Administrators. He hath given granted Bargained and sold Aliened Infeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents DOTH give Grant bargain sell Alien Infeoff and Confirm unto him the said Nathel Denton his heirs and assigns for Ever All that Tract or parcell of Land called WORTHEN lying and being in Cecil County in the province aforesaid BEGINNING at a Bounded Red Oak being the Westernmost Bounds of a parcell of Land called Clifton laid out for John Browning standing on the west side of a small Branch and running west sixty perches then West and by South one hundred perches to a Bounded white Oak standing upon the side of a Hill nigh the Head of a small Cove then South three hundred and seventy perches to a marked Hickory then South East and by East one hundred perches then East and by South seventy two perches till it intersect the said Clifton then binding on the said Intersection to the first mentioned Bounds containing and laid out for four hundred and fifty four acres of Land more or less Together with all Houses plantations Fences Improvements and all Manner of appurtenances Belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the same Land and Premises called WORTHEN with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said Nathel Denton his heirs and assigns for Ever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Nathel Denton his heirs and assigns for Ever. And to no other use intent or purpose whatsoever AND the said William Worthington DOTH hereby for himselfe his heirs Executors and Administrators and Every of them COVENANT promise Grant and agree to and with the said Nathel Denton his heirs and assigns That he the said Wm.
