meaning of the same Deed and the act of Assembly in
such case made and provided and at the same time came
Anne the wife of the said Jachel Denton who being
secretly examined out of the hearing of her husband
Declared that she relinquished her right of Dower to
the Land and premises above mentioned willingly and
freely and without being induced thereto by force or
threats of or ill usage by her husband or fear of
his displeasure according to act of Assembly in
such case made and provided
