 Witnesseth that whereas Anthony Johnson of Balt^o: County deced father
 of the said Benjⁿ: and Thomas Johnson had granted unto him a certain Tract
 of Land called Johnsons Interest lying and being in Baltimore County Cont^y:
 three hundred & Sixty acres of Land as by the Certificate thereof bearing
 date the Eighth day of October Anno Domini 1695 One hundred Sixty acres
 thereof was by the said Anthony conveyed unto a certain John Gattrolle
 the remaining two hundred acres whereof became the Right & Estate of
 the said Benjⁿ: & Thomas by the last will & Testament of the said
 Anthony as may appear Now This Indenture further Witnesseth
 that the said Benjamin Johnson & Tho^s: Johnson for and in consideration of
 the sum of forty pounds current money of Maryland to them in ^{well & truly} paid
 and satisfied by the said Charles Caroll the Proprietor whereof they do hereby
 acknowledge & thereof do acquit him the said Charles his heirs &c^s
