

whole personal Estate aforesaid shall have and may be lawfull for him the
said Benjamin his Heires Executors and Administrators to have hold
occupy posſeſſ and enjoy the same without sale or moleſtment or waste as fully
and freely as if these presents had never been made until the Recd. of the
