A Proclamation

Whereas his Lordship the Right Honourable
the Lord Proprietor of this Province has signified his dis-
sents to the Acts of Assembly here after mentioned
To wit To an Act for ascertaining the form of the
Oath of Judges or Justice AND to an Act to ascer-
tain the fees of Practitioners of the Law within
this Province and to prevent Exortions frauds and
Abuses upon made at a session of Assembly begun
and held at the City of Annapolis the Twenty
First Day of May Anno Domini 1700

Given of his Lordship's dissent to this Law
