 twenty & four & in the tenth year of the Reigne of Our Sovereign  
 Lord George by the grace of God of Great Britton France & Ireland  
 King Defender of the faith and Between William Vinos of the  
 parish of Overworton County of Stafford in y<sup>e</sup> Colony & Dom-  
 inion of Virginia of the one part and John Todd of the same  
 parish County & Colony of y<sup>e</sup> other part Witnesseth that the  
 aforesaid William Vinos Esq<sup>r</sup> of Baltimore County & provinces of  
 Maryland for y<sup>e</sup> Consideration of y<sup>e</sup> Summ of seven thousand  
 pounds of good tob<sup>o</sup> in Cash paid to him all ready in hand paid  
 by him y<sup>e</sup> J<sup>r</sup> Todd or secured to be paid and for divers other good  
 & Considerations him the said William Vinos Thers unto Especially  
 moving hath Given granted Bargained And sold allined  
 Exposed & Confirmed by these presents doth for himself his heirs  
 Exors Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assigns doth give grant Bargain allien Exposed; &  
 Confirmed unto y<sup>e</sup> J<sup>r</sup> John Todd his heirs Exors or Assigns for  
 ever a certain peice or parcel of Land lying & being situated  
 in Baltimore County in the province of Maryland Commonly  
 Called or known by the name of Vinos Chancel lying in  
 Baltimore County <sup>above</sup> the Elk Ridge one y<sup>e</sup> branches of y<sup>e</sup> Inter-  
 ent River in the woods begining at a bounded White oak a  
 Black oak & a poplar standing by a Run. Called Ridgelyes  
 Run. On y<sup>e</sup> South side of y<sup>e</sup> Run & runs thence South west by  
 South thirty six perches to a bounded Black oak then South  
 South East two hundred perches then South East & by East two hundred  
 & twenty perches then north East & by North twenty four perches  
 to y<sup>e</sup> Run then north y<sup>e</sup> Run by a straight line to y<sup>e</sup> first tree contain-  
 ing & laid out for two hundred acres of Land more or less according  
 to Certificate of Survey thers of taken & returned unto our Land  
 office bearing Date the fifth day of August One thousand seven  
 hundred & six & Thers remaining together w<sup>th</sup> all right profits  
 and Bonofits & privillidges thers unto belounging or in any wise  
 appertaining unto him the said John Todd his heirs or assigns  
 for ever more to be holden of y<sup>e</sup> Chief Lord or Lords of the  
 soc or fees by y<sup>e</sup> Rents & Services due & accustomed to be  
 to be paid and the said William Vinos doth for him self  
 his heirs & agreement & agreement to & with y<sup>e</sup> J<sup>r</sup> John Todd his  
 heirs or assigns that the before Granted promises with their  
 & every of their Appurtenances are freed & Clear & shall  
 will at all times & for ever hereafter ~~and~~ Warrant & depend  
 y<sup>e</sup> same from none & from any heirs or Assigns or from ~~any~~
