

This Indenture made the sixteenth day of Aprill in the year
of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and twenty five.
Between Tho: Brown of Baltemore County in the Province of
Maryland Planter of the one part and Amos Garritt of the City
of Annapolis in the Province of Maryland Merchant of the other
Witnesseth that whereas Thomas Brown by his last will and Testament
bearing date the Twenty Second day of March one thousand seven
hundred and fifty ^{een} amongst bequests to his other sons did give and
bequeath unto the said Tho: Brown his fourth surviving son his Potuont
Plantation and all the Land Adjourning to it that he held excepting
one hundred acres of Land which will is Lodged in the Prerogative
Court and proved and by a certain Deed of Indenture made the 17th
day of Feb: 1713 Between Thomas Brown father of the said Tho: of
Anne Arundell County Planter of the one ^{part} and the said Amos Garrit
remaining on record in the Provincial Land records Liber P.M. 1 folio
205 for the Considerations therein mentioned Did give grant bargain
sell assigne enjoy and confirm unto the said Amos his heirs and assigns
the said Potuont Plantation and all the Land adjourning to it with
other Tracts lying in Baltemore County and in this County as therein
specified under certain Conditions Provisos and Engagem^{ts} w^{ch}
were unsatisfied in the whole or part by Tho: Brown or by the
heirs at Law Tho: Brown who by a Deed of Indenture made
the 14 October: 1715 acknowledged and recorded in the Provincial
Land records of Maryland Liber P.M. folio 339 for the Consideration
therein mentioned did there by alienate assigne sell and make
over to his ~~father~~ ^{brother} Brother John Brown all his right title equity and
right of Redemption of in and to the Estate of his father Thomas
Brown deceased and the said John Brown second son having bought
his said Elder Brother and heirs at Law rights as of by a certain
Deed of Indenture made the 8th August: 1716 Between the said John
Brown of Ann Arundell County Planter of the one part and the said
Amos Garritt remaining on record in the Provincial Land records
Liber P.M. 1 folio 389 for the Consideration therein mentioned and
having the right of his said Brother Thomas did remit release and
for ever quit all Claims that he then had from or by his Brother
Tho: or that the said John Brown and his heirs hereafter shall have
of in and unto all and every Part of the several tracts of Land
conveyed Over by his fathers Deed first mentioned unto the said
Amos Garritt his heirs and assigns and Joshua Brown the
third son by a certain Deed of Indenture made the 19th day of
November 1718 betwen the said Joshua Brown of Baltemore
