Now This Indenture farther Witnesseth that the said Vol Brown for and in consideration that in case the several Tracts of Land made over were Duely valued so as the whole might bear the same due to Amos Garret the Proportion thereof that the Potucont Plantation and all the Land adjoining to it bequeath'd to him should pay therefor the said Valentins Brown for and in consideration of besides or over and above of the just sume of Eighty Pounds Curr: Money to the said Vol Brown w<sup>h</sup> hand paid by the said Amos Garret the receipt where of the said Vol doth here by acknowledge of the said Vol Brown by these presents do hereby remise release and for ever quit all manner of Claims that I have by virtue of my father Thomas Browns Will and bequest to me or hereafter shall have of in and unto the Potucont <sup>plantation</sup> and all the land adjoining to it or any part of the said Land and Premises afo<sup>r</sup> unto him the said Amos Garret his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Vol Brown for himself and his heirs absolutely releas into the said Amos Garret all manner of right or advantages that the said Vol now hath or hereafter may have to any Equity of redemption of the aforesaid Land and premises to the said Amos his heirs and assigns for ever In Witness where of the said party's hath herunto Intorechangably set to their hands and seals the Day and year afo<sup>r</sup>
