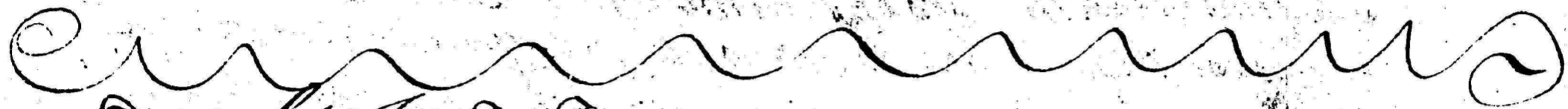


Worthington his heirs and assigns for ever according to the true

 thereto by fears or threats or flattery by her husband or fear of
 his displeasure according to act of assembly in that case made before
 me the Lord Proprietary Chief Justice of the provincial Court the
 day and year first above written Samuel Young

Done May 4th 1675



This Indenture made the twenty seventh Day of July
 in the ninth year of the reign of Our Sovereign Lord George by the
 grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender
 of the faith and in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven
 hundred and twenty four Between Thomas Bladen of the parish
 of St. James within the liberty of Westminster of the County of
 Middlesex Esq. of the one part and Thomas Colmore of the City of
 London merchant of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas
 Bladen for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings paid
 to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Colmore before the sealing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents
 doth bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Colmore All that the
 manor or Lordship or reputed manor or Lordship called Kent-
 fote manor situate lying and being in Kent Island in the
^{province} of Maryland in America and all the Lands Tenements
 and hereditaments thereunto belonging or thereunto with used
 and enjoyed together with all and singular the houses Outhouses
 Edifices Buildings Beams Stables Erections Structures Gardens Ways
 easements water water courses profits and ^{appurtenances} whatsoever
 to have and to hold the said manor or Lordship or reputed manor
 or Lordship and all and singular other the premises hereby
 bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be hereby bargained
 and sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the
 said Thomas Colmore his Executors Administrators and assigns
 from the day next before the day of the date
