This Indenture made the nineteenth day of  
 May Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred  
 and twenty four Between John Burgess of Anne  
 Arundell County in the Province of Maryland  
 Planter and Jane his wife lately called Jane  
 Macle fresh of y<sup>e</sup> one part and Samuel Poole of  
 London Town of the same County and province  
 of Maryland of the Other part Witnesseth  
 That Whereas a certain David Macle fresh  
 the father of the said Jane party to these presents  
 was seized in his life time and at the time of his  
 Death of all that tract or parcel of Land called  
 Cross his forest Lying near Patuxent River  
 beginning at a bounded poplar standing in  
 the side of a small branch falling into a branch  
 of Patuxent called Riders great Branch and  
 running from the S<sup>th</sup> End North West one  
 hundred ninety four perches to two bounded white  
 oaks standing on the west side of a small  
 branch falling into Elk horns branch then  
 North East fifty perches to a bounded red  
 oak then North west two hundred sixty  
 five perches to a bounded Span: Oak standing  
 near the head of a Sawmill then South  
 west one hundred fifty two perches to a
