

This Indenture made the Third Day of August In the Seventh
 year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George King of Great Britain
 Anno Domini the thousand seven hundred and twenty five
 Between John Vines of Annerundell County In the province of
 Maryland planter of the one part & John Brown of Annerundell
 County In said province of Maryland Planter of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said John Vines for and In consideration of the sum
 of five pounds fifteen Shillings ^{current} money to him In hand paid by the
 said John Brown the Receipt whereof the said John Vines Both hereby
 Acknowledge and thereof doth fully discharge the said John Brown
 his heirs &c. and Assigns hath bargained sold Alien
 Enfeoffed and confirmed as by these presents he Both for himself
 and his heirs bargained sell alien Enfeoffed and confirmed unto him the
 John Brown his heirs and Assigns for ever all that parcel of Land
 called Bachelor's Hope lying In the County of Baltimore Near
 Elk Ridge Beginning at Two bounded Heavory Trees and two bounded
 white Oakes and Running South fourteen deg^s East thirty six poles
 thence South eighty seven deg^s East thirty eight poles then South
 sixty eight deg^s East eighteen poles thence South sixteen deg^s East
 thirty eight poles thence North sixteen deg^s East forty poles thence
 north sixty three deg^s west twenty six poles thence North thirty
 seven deg^s west seventy poles thence North eighty three deg^s west
 sixty poles thence South twenty three deg^s East forty six poles then
 with a strait Line to the said bounded Trees containing and laid out for
 twenty five acres of Land more or less to be held of the manor of
 Baltimore According to a Certificate of a Survey thereof taken
 and Returned unto his Lordships Land office bearing Date the
 twentieth Day of October on thousand seven hundred & nineteen
 & thereof Remaining together with all rights profits & benefits
 to have and to hold that tract of Land with the Appurtenances
 unto the said John Brown his heirs and Assigns for ever to no other
 use Intent or purposes whatsoever & privileges thereunto belonging
 In anywise appertaining to be holden of y^e King's High Lord of y^e
 Manor by the Rents and Services Due and Accustomed
