<sup>x</sup> This Indenture made the fifth day of July in the Eleventh year of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Brittain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith & in the Tenth year of his Lordships Dominion & Annoque Domini one thousand seven hundred and twenty five, between Thomas Sarkin of the City of Annapolis Esq of the one part and George Plater Edmund Jennings of the same place Esq of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Thomas Sarkin for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and five pounds current money of the province of Maryland to him in hand paid by the said George Plater and Edmund Jennings before the Signing and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he Doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof and of every part and parcel thereof doth fully cleare and absolutely acquitt Release and Discharge them the said George Plater and Edmund Jennings and each of them their and each of their Executors Administrators and Assignes and every of them by these presents and for divers other good causes and Considerations him thereunto moving he the said Thomas Sarkin hath Granted Bargained sold aliend Enjoyned
