Then came the above named Thomas Cockey before me the Subscriber one of the Justices of the Right Honourable the Lord Propriety his Privy Court and acknowledged the above mentioned Land & promises & every part & parcel thereof to be the right & Estate of the above named Benjamin mead his heirs and assigns for ever according to the true intent & meaning of the said Deed and at the same time came Elizabeth the wife of the said Thomas who being secretly Examined out of the hearing of her said husband Declared that she ^{voluntarily} ~~voluntarily~~ her Right of Dowry to the land and promises above mentioned willingly & freely without being Induced thereto by fears or threats of or ill usage by her said husband or fear of him Displeasur according to Act of Assembly in that Case made and Provided
