provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore
To all Our Bailiffs and Good people to whom these presents shall come *Know*
We that of Our Special Grace we have pardoned unto *Ellis Francis* late of *Calvert*
County Labourer as a proper Object of Our Mercy the Suit of Our peace and
whatsoever appertaineth to us for that the said *Ellis Francis* by the twelfth
day of November which was in the year of Our Lord God seven hundred thirty
and one with force and Arms at the Delusion House of a certain *Jacob Cole* of
Oxford in the County aforesaid in the Night time vizt between the tenth and the
eleventh hours after the close of the same day feloniously and burglariously
did break and enter and then stealing furrow money of Maryland in Money
numbered One shilling Great Coat of the value of ten shillings like money One shilling
Jacob of the value of one shilling and three pence like money One pair of green
Stockings of the value of one shilling like money One pound wife of the value
of six pence like money One Silver shirt bundle of the value of one shilling
and six pence like money One pair of brass shoes of the value of six
pence like money of the Goods and Chattels of the said *Jacob Cole* in the said
House then and there being found then and there feloniously and burglariously
did steal take and carry away against our peace good rule and Government whereof
he was found before our Trusty and well beloved *Gov^r in Chiefe* and *James*
Boothby Esq^r our Justices of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery for
our said County of *Calvert* And Grant unto him our full peace and will not
that he suffer any corporal punishment therefore but that he shall notwithstanding
he shall stand and be in the same plight State and condition to all intents and
purposes as if the said felony and burglary whereof the said *Ellis Francis* hath
been found had never been done or committed *Witness* Our Trusty and well
beloved *Saml Ogle* Esq^r *Gov^r in Chiefe* and *Sam^l Ogle* in and over said
provinces of Maryland this twentieth fourth day of October in the eighth
year of Our Dominion of Annoq^{ue} Dni 1732
