

if the said Hollin Subb should happen to survive the said Mrs Campbell her then intended Husband that then and in such case from immediately after the Death of the said John Campbell the same Goods and Chattels mentioned in the Schedule in the said Deed mentioned and every of them should be accounted as the proper Goods & Chattels & Estate of the said Hollin Subb and should be received and taken by the said Hollin Subb for & in his own Name and should be employed & disposed to such person or persons and to and for such Use and uses Intents and purposes and in such Manner and form as the said Hollin Subb at any time thereafter should think good to limit appoint or Order Give Devise or Dispose of the same Goods or Chattels or any part or Parts thereof or otherwise and in case the said Hollin should survive the said John Campbell as aforesaid and should not make any Disposition of the said Goods and Chattels in her life time that then the same Goods & Chattels or so much thereof as should not be by her the said Hollin Subb disposed of in her life time should be had and taken by the Heirs of the said Hollin Subb any thing in the said recited Deed to the contrary notwithstanding by which Deed it was provided that the several Goods & Chattels in the Schedule therein mentioned should lie at the Discretion of the said Hollin Subb or those that might or should have Right thereto by Virtue of the same Deed as by the said Deed Acknowledged and recorded among the proceedings of Ann Arundole County Court may appear and whereas since the Execution of the above recited Deed the said Marriage hath been had and solemnized and the before mentioned parties to the said Deed are all alive **NOW KNOW** all MEN by these presents that Hollin Campbell now the wife of the said John Campbell lately called Hollin Subb and by and with the Consent of her said Husband John Campbell hereby signified by his Signing and Sealing these presents and by Virtue of the provisions to her contained & referred by the said recited Indented Deed hath revoked and made void and doth hereby revoke and make void the said recited Deed and all and singular every Order, Disposition, Appointment, Limitation, Gift, Devise, and Sum and Sums of Money hereby Ordered or to be paid to the said several persons therein mentioned and Sums of Money therein and thereby Ordered to be paid out and every other thing therein contained as if the said recited Indented Deed had never been made or executed excepting only the aforesaid Sum of Fifty pounds current Money which by the said Deed is provided to be paid unto the aforesaid Margt Martmore in witness whereof the said John Campbell and Hollin his wife have hereunto set their hands & seals this fourth Day of September Anno Domini 1732
