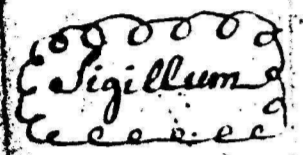

Charles Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore To Our Right Trusty and well beloved the Upper and Lower Houses of our General Assembly, and to all others in our said Province for the time being Greeting WHEREAS at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Eleventh day of July and ending the Eighth day of August in the Eighteenth year of Our Dominion Annoq; Domini 1732 An Act to prevent Bribery and Corruption in the Election of Citizens or Delegates to serve in Assembly for the City of Annapolis passed into a Law, On due Consideration thereof We have thought fit to Dissent to the said Law, and do hereby declare the said Law Null, Void, and of no Effect GIVEN at Annapolis this twenty third day of January in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion Annoq; Domini 1732.
