

 one thousand seven hundred & thirty two Between Richard Dicks of Annapolis  
 County in the province of Maryland planter of the One part & Robert Boons of  
 the same County & province planter of the Other part Witnesseth that the  
 said Richard Dicks for & in consideration of the sum of twelve pounds & five  
 shillings Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Robert Boons at & before  
 the signing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof to the said Richard  
 Dicks doth hereby acknowledge and thereof & therefrom doth hereby acquit  
 & discharge the said Robert Boons his heirs & assigns for ever  
 both given granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed and by  
 these presents doth give Grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the  
 said Robert Boons his heirs & assigns for ever a Grant or parcel of Land  
 lying in Baltimore County in the province of Maryland bounded as followeth that is to say Beginning at three bounded white  
 oak trees standing on the East Side of a branch and on the North Side of four  
 fathoms North forty nine degrees East one hundred & six poles  
 fourteen degrees West one hundred thirty nine poles thence North  
 West one hundred thirty three poles thence North Seventy three degrees  
 West one hundred and twenty five acres more or less. Together with  
 the woods & passages woods & underwoods timber & and Timber trees water and  
 water courses whatsoever and all other the Appurtenances therunto be-  
 longing or in any wise Appertaining. To have & to hold the said Land  
 and all and singular the premises with the Appurtenances as aforesaid unto the said  
 Robert Boons his heirs & assigns & to his & their only proper use & behoofe  
 for ever And the said Richard Dicks doth hereby further promise covenant & grant
