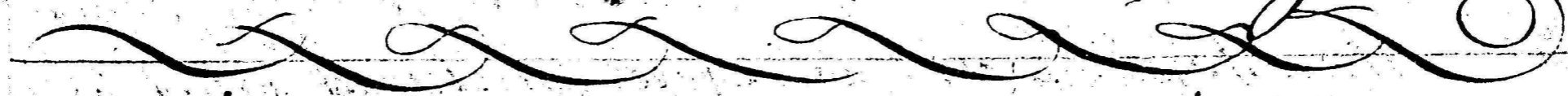

This Indenture made this Seventeenth Day of Novem-  
ber in the Year of Our Lord God One Thousand Seven hundred  
thirty two Between Edward Evans of Baltimore County  
in the Province of Maryland planter of the one part and  
Walter Dallas of the said County & Province Merchant of the  
other part Witnesseth that the said Edward Evans for &  
in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds Currant money to him  
in hand paid by the said Walter Dallas the receipt whereof the  
the said Edward Evans doth here by Confess & Acknowledge  
he the said Edward Evans Hath Granted Bargained Sold  
Aliened confirmed and by these presents Doth Grant barg-  
ain Sell Alien & Confirm unto the said Walter Dallas  
his Heirs & Assignes for ever All that Tract or parcell of  
Land called or known by the Name of Kindness Lying in  
Baltimore County on the South side of Back River adjoining  
to a parcell of Land called Burmans Forest Beginning at  
a bounded Red Oak it being a bounded tree of the said Forest  
then South South west Sixty eight perches to a bounded  
Spanish Oak of the said Forest then South east fifty six  
perches to a bounded <sup>tree</sup> of the said Forest then <sup>South</sup> west thirty  
two perches to a bounded Chesnut of the said Forest then  
North west one hundred Eighty two perches to a bound
