 Sum of One hundred & fifty pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain
 To him in hand paid by the s^d. Thomas Buckner before the Envoaling
 & Delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby
 Acknowledge & thereof of every part thereof Doth Acquit and
 Discharge him the s^d. Thomas Buckner his heirs & Assigns
 & every of them by these Presents hath Granted Bargained &
 Sold Alien'd Released Conveyed & Confirmed & by these Presents
 Doth fully and absolutely Grant Bargain and Sell Alien release
 Convey and Confirm unto the said Thomas Buckner in his
 Actual possession now being of the severall Tracts or Parces of
 Land lying in Baltimore County in the Province of Maryland or
 Elsewhere within the s^d. Province whereof William Buckner brother
 To the s^d. John Buckner dyed possessed either in Fact or in Law with
 the Appurtenances by Virtue of One Indenture of Bargain & Sale
 To him thereof made for one whole year by Indenture bearing
 Date the Day before the Day of the Date of these Presents &
 of the Statute for Transferring Uses into Possession to his
 Heirs & Assigns for ever & all Ways Woods Waters Profits
 Commodities Emoluments Hereditaments & Appurtenances
 whatsoever to the s^d. hereby Granted Released Conveyed
