This Indenture made the Twenty fifth Day of February in the fourth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c. Annoq^{ue} Domⁱⁿⁱ. One Thousand seven hundred and Thirty Between Henry Darnall of Prince Georges County in the Province of Maryland in America at present Residing in the City of London Esq. and Ann his wife of the One part, and William Black of London Merchant of the Other part. Whereas the said Henry Darnall is justly and truly Indebted unto the said William Black in the Sum of Two Thousand and four hundred pounds of Good and Lawfull money of Great Britain for money Lent and paid to and for the said Henry Darnall as by an Account this Day made up by the said William Black and signed and approved of by the said Henry Darnall may appear. And Whereas the said Henry Darnall is seized of a Good Estate of Inheritance in Fee Simple of and in all and Singular the Land and Premises hereafter Menconed. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for Securing the payment of the said Sum of Two Thousand and four hundred pounds And also for and in Consideration of the Sum of Five Shillings of Lawfull money of Great Britain unto the said Henry Darnall and Ann his wife in hand well and truly paid by the said William Black at or before the sealing and Delivery (of)
