This Indenture Quadrupartite made the fourth day of June  
 in the Seventeenth year of the Dominion of the Noble Lord Charles  
 Absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Province of Maryland <sup>and in the year by our said Lord Charles</sup> Between  
 Charles Diggs of Prince Georges County in the Province of Maryland Gent  
 and Susanna Maria his Wife of the first part Edward Meale of Charles  
 County in the Province of Gent of the second part Francis Meale of Prince  
 Georges County of Gent and Dorothy his Wife of the third part and  
 Henry Darnall of Ann Arundell County in the Province of Gent and  
 Elizabeth his Wife of the other part Witnesses that whereas  
 Nicholas Lowe of St Marys County in the same Province by  
 deed seized of several tracts or parcels of Land within the Province  
 of (that is to say) A Tract of Land lying in St Marys County of  
 on the South side of Patuxent River (part of Delabrook Manor  
 being called the Great plantation at Patuxent supposed to  
 contain One thousand acres Several parcels of Land lying Situate  
 and being at and about the Court house in St Marys County of  
 containing by Estimation nine hundred and Seventeen Acres Six  
 hundred and twelve acres part thereof called Friends Goodwill Two  
 hundred and twenty Acres of Land being part of his Lordships Manor  
 of Beaverdam lying in St Marys County of One other Tract of  
 Land lying in St Marys County of called Worthington or Middle rock  
 containing three hundred and fifty Acres One thousand Acres of Land being  
 part of a Tract of Land laid out for fifteen hundred Acres called Golden  
 Grove lying in Dorchester County in the Province of fifteen hundred  
 acres of Land being part of a tract laid out for five thousand Acres  
 called Barbadoes lying in Charles County of a Tract of Land called  
 Henertha Maria lying formerly in Charles County but now in Prince  
 Georges County on the branches of the Eastern Branch of Potomack River  
 laid out for five hundred Acres One other Tract of Land lying in Kent  
 County in the Province of called Bennetts Lowe containing fourteen  
 hundred acres One other Tract of Land lying in Cecil County in the  
 Province of called Spryes Hill containing five hundred Seventy three  
 Acres and one other tract of Land lying in Kent County of called  
 Green Oak containing four hundred and fifty Acres and for what is  
 yet known the said Nicholas Lowe in his lifetime had right to though  
 not actual possession of several other tracts or parcels of Land lying in  
 the Counties of St Marys Charles & Prince Georges All whereas all  
 the said Lands are now Descended and come to the said Susanna  
 Maria Diggs Sister of the said Nicholas Lowe to Elizabeth Darnall
