 his late father Deed whereby the s<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Hyde hath impos-  
 ed Rich<sup>d</sup> Bennett of Queen Anne County in the province  
 of Maryland in America to recover and receive from  
 all persons in Maryland as well the Debts due to the  
 estate of the s<sup>d</sup> John Hyde Deed as to the s<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Hyde  
 on his own proper act or to that effect And this Deed  
 saith that the s<sup>d</sup> Deed fol<sup>l</sup> or letter of Attorney was recei-  
 ved and Delivered by the s<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Hyde in the presence of  
 this Deed and Sam<sup>l</sup> Johnson and that in Testimony of  
 the Sealing and Delivery thereof by the s<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Hyde  
 as of this Deed and the s<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>l</sup> Johnson did severally  
 subscribe their Names as Witnesses thereto And that the  
 Name Walter Hoxton now appearing as a Witne<sup>s</sup> thereto  
 is of this Deed his own proper hand writing
