Chirurgeon of the Other part Witnesseth that the said  
George Walker for & in Consideration of the sum of two  
hundred pounds Curr<sup>t</sup> money to him in hand paid by the  
said James Walker the Receipt Whereof the said George  
Walker Doth hereby Acknowledge Hath Granted  
Bargained & Sold & by these presents Doth Grant Bargain  
& Sell unto the said said Walker & his heirs for ever all that  
two parcels of Land <sup>lying</sup> on the East side of the main road <sup>that</sup> now leads  
from Annapolis to Patuxent ferry the One Called Bodys Adventure  
& the Other Called Gardners Addition According as the same is  
Discribed & Bounded in a Deed of Gift by John Gardner to  
Susanna his Daughter & all houses Buildings Gardens & Orchard  
Lands Woods & Advantages whatsoever to the said two parcels or  
Tracts
