provinces of Maryland & Avalon in America & also
Commander in Chief both by Sea & Land of all the forces
Raised or to be Raised within the Limits of our said
provinces or the Islands Territories & Dominions thereunto
Belonging And over all such forces to appoint proper
Officers & them to move & Displace at your will &
pleasure And further we Doe by these presents
Impower & Authorize you our said Trusty & well beloved
Samuel Ogle to call & Summon any Generall Assembly or
assembly & them to prorogue or Dissolve at your own will & pleasure
And Likewise in our name but with the Advice and
Consent of our Council & the Delegates of the freemen in the said
provinces in Assembly Convened to make & Enact such Laws
