1731. Then came before us Two of his Lordships Justices of Prince
Georges County the within Named Henry Darnall Esq^r who
acknowledges the within instrument as his act & Deed
and the Lands & Premises therein, mentioned to be the
right of the within Named William Black, his heirs
and assigns, according to the true Intent and Meaning of
the within Deed, and the act of Assembly in that Case made
and provided, and at the same time the within Named Ann
Darnall the wife of the said Henry Darnall being Examined
privately & out of the hearing of her said Husband acknow-
ledged the within instrument as her act and Deed and
released her right of Dower to the within said and
premises to the said William Black his heirs and
assigns for ever, and declared she made the same acknow-
ledgements willingly and freely and without being indu-
ced thereto by force or threats or ill usage of her said
Husband or fear of his displeasure according to the true in-
tent & meaning of the within Deed and the act of Assembly
in that Case made and provided.
