by his Last will & Testament in writing bearing date the
twenty sixth day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred
& twenty six Signed & Sealed in the presence of three
Witnesses & duly proved according to Law as by the same
will duly entered upon Record in the Comissary Generalls
Office in this province for probat of wills & granting
administrations Reference being there unto had more
fully appears & Amongst other things therein contained
made the following Devise Item I give & bequeath unto
my beloved son John Bradford one Dwelling house with a
small Orchard & Back side also one Tenement containing
