This indenture made the 20th day of July in the third year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord Lady King William & Queen Mary in the year of our Lord God One Thousand Six hundred Ninety One Between Thomas Gibson of Charles County in the province of Maryland Plaintiff of the one part Doctor James Hensbury of the same County & province of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas Gibson for in consideration of Six Thousand pounds of Tobacco to him the said Thomas Gibson at or before the executing and delivery of these presents in hand paid by the said James Hensbury as for Divers other good causes and considerations him herunto moving have given granted Bargained sold aliened Transferred Release confirmed and by these presents doe give Grant Bargain Well alien Transferred Release confirm unto the said James Hensbury his heirs assigns for ever all that Tract or parcel of Land lying on the South Side of Middle River in Baltimore County being part of a Tract of Land of four hundred and fifty acres known by the name of North wecke and formerly granted to Major Thomas Longe of Baltimore County & beginning at a Bounded white Oak Standing on the North Side of a Creek and Running South West Fifty perches to a Bounded Red Oak Standing on the West Side of a Cove in the Line of the Land formerly laid out for Richard Wells Gent. and running with a Line of the said Land West South West three hundred and twenty perches to a marked Chesnut Oak Standing in the Line of Cap^{ts} Cornwalls Land then with the Line of the said Cornwalls Land East Two hundred and ten perches to a Bounded Oak Standing in the West Line of the said Cornwalls Land then by a straight Line to the first Bound Tree containing and now said Oak for four hundred fifty and seven acres of
