Cash 7. This Indenture made the twenty seventh day of Nov^r in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty three -
 Between Dan Canole of Duddington Mannour in Prince Georges
 County Esq^r of the one part and Charles Diggs and Daniel Canole of
 Marlborough of the same County Gentlemen of the other part Witnesseth
 that whereas by the last will and Testament of John Bradford of the
 County afo^r dated bearing date the 26th day of March Anno Domini
 seven hundred and twenty six did amongst other the things
 therein give and bequeath to his son John Bradford and his
 heirs for ever one Dwelling house with a small Orchard and
 backside also one Tennisment containing one Piece of Pasture Ground
 and one Piece of Meadow and several parcels of Tillage lying upon
 fields near a Village called Thirskison in the County of Westchester in
 the Kingdom of Great Britain also all them parcels of Land being
 parturage lying near the Town of Stoke Golding in the County of Westchester
 then in the possession of the father of the afo^r John Bradford deceased
 which said parcels of Land are severally known by the names
 hereafter mentioned viz^t Wykin hole, Peggys Wykin hole, Olden Close
 Peggys Olden Close also the Dwelling house and Orchard and all Out
 houses and other Improvements belonging to the said dwelling house
 wherein the father of the afo^r John Bradford deceased did then live
 reference being had to the said will afo^r more fully and at large appear
 and whereas the said John Bradford Legatee of his father deceased
 has by Indenture bearing date the 9th day of July one thousand
 seven hundred and thirty three sold and conveyed to the aforesaid
 Daniel Canole of Duddington Mannour and his heirs for the
 consideration therein mentioned all his right Title and Interest
 unto the afo^r Lands lying in the Kingdom of Great Britain left him
