KNOW all men by these presents that Sam: Griffith of Calvert County
Planter do owe & stand justly Indebted to Lewis Griffith of the same County
Planter his heirs or assigns in the full sum of three hundred pounds
Current money of Maryland to which payment well & truly to be
Made binding self my heirs & assigns firmly by these
presents with his hand & seal this second Day of March One
Thousand Seven hundred thirty two three.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas
I the above bound Sam: Griffith hath this Day agreed to give
the above Lewis Griffith all the Land hereafter specified being
part of a Tract called Welch pools Beginning at the third Bounded
Tree of the whole Tract it being a Poplar & Stand at the head of a Branch
called the Muddy Branch running from thence with the Branch
to the Southernmost Line of the whole Tract called Welch pools as
afores: thence with the Southernmost Line East North East to the
South East Corner Tree of the whole Tract thence North with the
Original Line of the whole Tract to the Original Bounded Tree of
the whole Tract thence with the Original Line of the whole Tract
to the first beginning Poplar together with all Profits & Advantages
thereunto belonging Reserving to my self During my Natural
Life all profits & Advantages thereunto belonging of the whole
bequest as afores: if it should so happen that my wife should if
she out Live me should claim any part of Dowry or into any
part of the aforesaid Land then the above Obligation to be good in Law
& Devoid it may be Lawfull for my son Lewis Griffith to
Sew my Estate for the Penalty afores: Thon this Obligation to be
void & Inane Effect or else to stand Remains & be in full power
Strength in Law.
