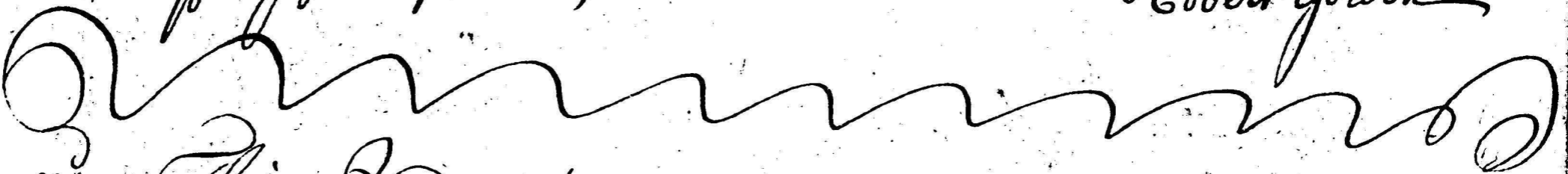


Joseph Hopkins his heirs & assigns for ever, at the same time Margarott

 Carroll Esq<sup>r</sup> & Charles Carroll Chyrurgon both of the City of  
 Annapolis in Ann Arundell County & John Diggs of Prince  
 Georges County Gent the Major part of the Executors of m<sup>r</sup>  
 James Carroll of Ann Arundell County Deceased on the other  
 part Witnesseth that the said Charles Carroll Esq<sup>r</sup> Charles  
 Carroll Chyrurgon & John Diggs as Executors & made  
 over unto him the said Daniel Carroll all that Tract or parcell  
 of Land called Trigger lying in Calvert County granted to  
 the said James Carroll by Patent of Confirmation September  
 the Thirtieth Seventeen hundred & Twenty Seven In Trust  
 & Confidence & to the use & purpose that an Ejectment may  
 be brought by them against the Tenant in possession of  
 the said Lands in the Name of the s<sup>r</sup> Daniel Carroll as by the  
 Deed thereof bearing date the sixth day of April anno  
 Dom<sup>o</sup> Seventeen hundred & thirty & recorded in the
