 sold alien Enfeoffed and confirmed to the said Wm Stoveron his heirs
 and a freehold for ever all that tract or parcele of Land called Briggs
 Holmstone Situate lying and being in Kent County containing to said
 out for one thousand acres more or less as the same was sold to the said
 Ariana by Henry Evans as also all that tract or parcele of Land called
 Baldwin's Addition lying in Anne Arundell County sold by John Baldwin
 to the said Ariana joinings together with all and singular the premises
 and appurtenances to each of the said tracts belonging to have & to hold the
 same with the appurtenances unto the said Wm Stoveron his heirs & assigns
 for ever In witness whereof the said parties to these presents have
 hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
