 or give Acquittances or Other Discharges for the same And for the
 better doing Acting performing or Executing of all or Any of the
 premises I Do hereby give unto my said Attorney full power and
 Authority to Constitute Appoint Authorize and in his place or
 Stead put One or more Attorney or Attornys for me And the same
 at his pleasure to Revoke and to Do Execute perform and finish
 for me and in my Name all and singular the things which shall be
 Expedient and Necessary in or about the premises or any of them as
 fully and amply to all intents and purposes as the said Thomas Black-
 ston might or could do if personally present Hereby Ratifying and
 Confirming all and whatsoever my said Attorney or his Substitutes
 shall Lawfully do or cause to be done in or about the premises
 And I Do hereby Revoke and Annule all former powers by me
 Made or Given to any Person or persons whatsoever In Witnes-
 s Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this
 Sixteenth Day of August Anno Dom 1733.
